Seasonal Flu Shot

Ask your doctor about getting the Seasonal Flu shot—your doctor knows best about whether you need a flu shot and can help you get shots for you and/or your family

H1N1 Flu Shot (Swine Flu)

The H1N1 Flu shot is available for certain groups and will be available for everyone in the future (see [Risk Groups](#) on this website to see if you should get a shot or call your doctor).

The H1N1 flu shot is considered safe but some people might have a reaction such as soreness, redness, tenderness or swelling in the area of the shot. There could be headache, muscle aches, fever, nausea or fainting (mainly with teenagers). Call your doctor if you have any of these symptoms after your flu shot.
